

## **MR FUNGUS DREAMS FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS**

### **WHERE IS THE SHOW?**

The venue is Circa Theatre, it is very easy to find, it's right next door to Te Papa Tongarewa the National Museum of New Zealand.

### **WHEN IS THE SHOW?**

The school season of MR FUNGUS DREAMS runs for four days only, Tuesday 19 until Friday 22 September, 2023. The public season continues from Saturday 23 September until Saturday 7 October, running Tuesday to Saturday with shows at 11am.

### **WHAT IS THE DURATION OF THE SHOW?**

The show will run at 45 to 50 minutes.

### **WHAT AGES DOES THE SHOW CATER TO?**

Suitable for all primary aged children. Also open for pre-school and older children.

### **HOW MUCH DOES IT COST TO SEE THE SHOW?**

There is a special discount for school groups, at \$10 per person.

Otherwise, it is:

\$15 per person

\$50/Groups of 4

\$10 per person for groups of 10+

### **DOES THE VENUE HAVE FACILITIES FOR US?**

The venue has a large foyer to accommodate full audiences waiting to get into a show.

There are toilet facilities available.

Also onsite, a cafeteria selling various food and drinks.

### **CAN THE STUDENTS EAT MORNING TEA BEFOREHAND?**

Being an 11am show, your school group may wish to bring your own snacks for prior to the performance. These can be eaten in the foyer.

### **CAN MEMBERS OF THE PUBLIC ATTEND THE SCHOOLS SHOWS?**

Yes, all shows are available for sale to the public. However, Wellington area schools will be given priority booking opportunity to book in groups for the four shows Tuesday 19 to Friday 22 September, prior to the tickets going on sale to the public (25 July).
